

PRIMARY ELECTION

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

➤ The New Jersey Primary Election has been rescheduled to Tuesday, July 7, 2020.

➤ No Sample Ballots are being mailed to voters for this Primary Election.

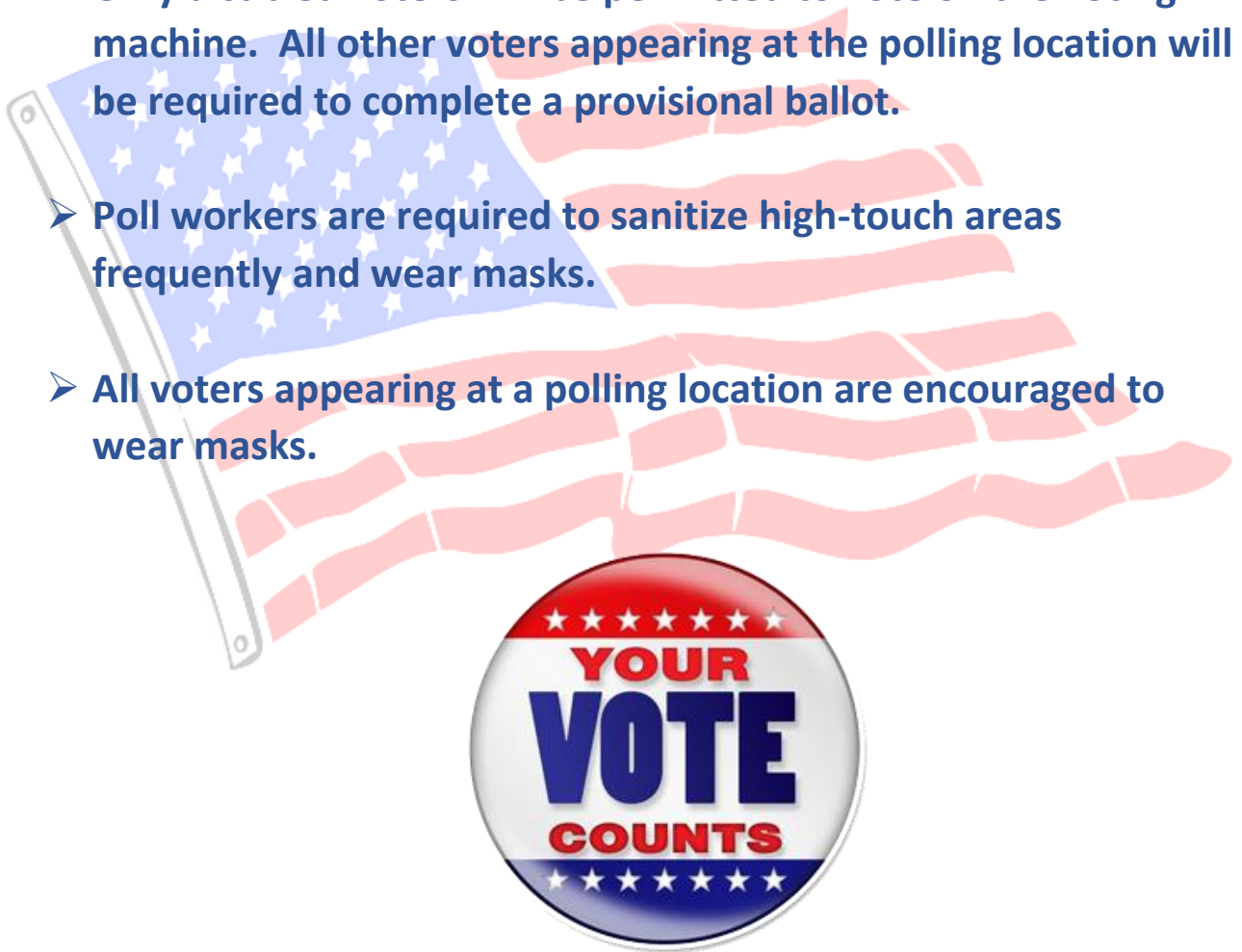
➤ All voters registered Democrat or Republican will receive a Vote-By-Mail ballot with a prepaid postage return envelope.

➤ All Unaffiliated voters will receive a postage-paid Vote-By-Mail *application*. Complete and return to receive a Vote-By-Mail ballot.

➤ NOTE: The County Clerk's office will mail all Vote-by-Mail ballots by June 12, 2020. If you do not receive your Vote-By-Mail ballot you should contact the County Clerk's office at (856) 453-4860.

➤ Vote-by-Mail ballots must be postmarked on or before July 7, 2020 and received by the County Board of Elections by July 14th.

- **Only one polling location may be open in Maurice River Township – John Boggs Hall, Port Elizabeth, NJ. All voters from Maurice River Township will vote at this location for the Primary Election on July 7th. The opening of this ‘one’ location is contingent on availability of Poll Workers.**
- **All voters must maintain a distance of 6-feet between each other. Signage will be present.**
- **Only disabled voters will be permitted to vote on the voting machine. All other voters appearing at the polling location will be required to complete a provisional ballot.**
- **Poll workers are required to sanitize high-touch areas frequently and wear masks.**
- **All voters appearing at a polling location are encouraged to wear masks.**
